Frankly, I am not sure if this dream has anything to do with current events. At a minimum, I see it as an encouragement from the Lord that what I have been receiving in words and dreams is from Him and not a fertile imagination.

On July 12, 2009, I had a dream about a couple that we knew over ten years ago. We have had no contact with them for at least this many years and had no idea what was going on in their lives. We remember them as a very close couple that loved the Lord. When they were courting, they were a picture of first love.

However, in the dream, the wife was sitting alone wondering what had happened. I was given the impression that her husband had walked away from her. I felt led to try to comfort her and help her understand.

I inquired how the couple was doing and received a strange look from my friends. They said, "Don't you know; they are divorced." Perhaps this is the Lord's way of validating the dreams and words that I receive.
